History – Ask an adult about their favourite toy when they were younger. How is it different to your favourite toy?



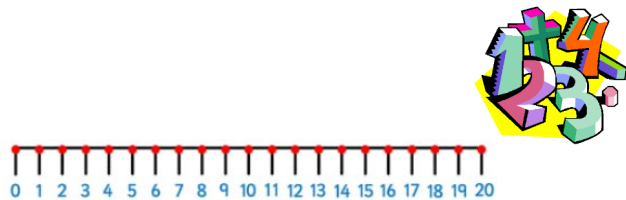
Art - Paper play—Practice folding paper or card to make 3D shapes. Can you roll it and scrunch it to make your own sculpture?

Science— Animals— Can you draw an animal you have or would like to keep as a pet? What would make them a good pet?



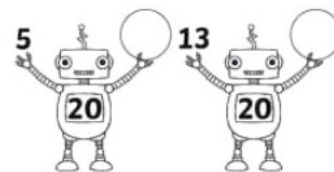
English – Create your own superhero and write a comic about them.
