Unsuitable Items

We know that trends in clothing and accessories can be appealing but sometimes these aren't suitable.

Some items aren't suitable because they could be dangerous, such as heeled shoes, shoes with wheels (Heelys etc.), crocks or open shoes and jewellery (apart from stud earrings). Items are also unsuitable if they are distracting, like extreme hairstyles or very large hair bows. If you are unsure, speak to the school office.
